

Board Meeting Minutes for April 11, 2024, 4:01 pm

CHAIR REPORTS

• Secretary: Sandee Scott
Wendy moved and Kerby seconded and the vote was unanimous to accept and approve minutes for the March YSA Board meeting.

• Treasurer: Monica Monica reported that we currently have 141 members. We have a total of \$23,413.58 in our bank accounts (including the two CDs; one for \$10,000 for 11 months at 4.64% and one for \$5,000 for 7 months at 4.16%). The \$15,000 in CDs is at Wells Fargo. Our account at USB has a balance of \$8,413.58.

Jennifer reported that she created a page for Au Naturale on the website and set up the Annual Anniversary Show on Smarter Entry which is now open. She also modified the Annual Show Page on the website for the current year. In addition she added all the dates of the shows to the calendar as well as rescheduling the demos and board meetings to the 2nd week of the month.

• YGAC:

Carolyn Hartling submitted a report that the exhibit featuring the work of Hannelore Fischer, Teresa J. Sharp and Lisa Greenstein will be coming down 5/12 with new participants bringing in art that same day. Installation of the new exhibit will be on Monday 5/13. The schedule has been shifted two days earlier than normal due to Carolyn's travel plans.

The new exhibit features Sandra Lee Scott, Rosalie Thurston and Lubov (Luba) Pavlok. Rosalie and Luba are showing their work in this venue for the first time. • Au Naturale Gina

Closing date for Au Naturale submissions is 4/13, with a possible extension to 4/15. The exhibit will run from 4/26 to 5/26. Reception will be 4/26. There will be ribbons but no prize money.

• 53rd Anniversary Show

The prospectus is up; show will be June 1 - June 30 at Gallery 5 at YGAC. Deadline for submissions is May 11th. See prospectus at <u>SmarterEntry.com</u> for further details. Barbara authorized \$100 for the reservation fee for the taco providers (Lupe & J). We will be paying \$800 to rent the gallery space at Gallery 5 for the show. Hanging of the show will take place 5/29. The reception is 6/8. Pick-up for the show is Monday, 7/1, 11 am to 4:30 pm.

- 3. Slate of officers Barbara reported that she's approached at least a half dozen people, all of whom have declined. We recommended a stand-alone email blast asking the membership to step up to the plate. Kerby offered to be President as a back-up plan, for which he was applauded.

New Business:

- 1. We have received a request from the Madera County Superintendent of Schools and Madera County Schools Foundation to participate in the ArtsFest held in Madera on May 13. Dottie Farnandez Lee has participated in the past but she is not available this year. Barbara will be contacting Autumn Ensign and Brooke Soukup to see if they have an interest.
- 2. The site of Fäsi Winery is now Dorval Estate Winery. They are willing to show art and to be a Plein air destination. Interested artists should contact them directly to discuss the possibilities. (Barbara will not be "brokering" this opportunity.)
- 3. Rooted, a business doing such things as a Farmers Market in Coarsegold, has several opportunities and offerings for artists, some of which require a nominal booth fee. The events take place on Fridays and the person to contact is Rose Morgan. Her tel. number is 559-760-3848. Interested artists are to make their own arrangements. (Barbara will not be "brokering" this opportunity.)
- 4. The Butterfly Festival in Mariposa is happening May 4th from 10:00 AM--6:00 PM, and May 5th from 10:00 AM--4:00 PM. There is a hefty booth fee. YSA is not participating.
