(Carolyn, Monica, Teresa Sharp). 6/1/— Judging by Ren Lee, Areej Latif and Jim Kocher at 11:00 am followed by lunch for the judges at Idle Hour (Barbara and Kerby to handle). Kerby will be providing the spread sheets for the judging (thank you, Kerby!). 6/1 — show officially opens. Sandee Scott will be making the labels..

The reception is 6/8/24 from 5 to 7 pm. (Set up crew needed between 2:00 and 3:00 — Vicki, Carolyn, Barbara, Kerby, Sandee). Clean up crew needed from 7:00 to 7:30 pm.
